

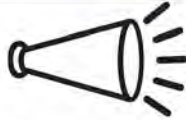

“My nephew, Jordan Blackburn, passed from this life November 9, 2020, at the age of 34. His lingering organ failure enabled him to be alert at times and communicate his sorrow over past behaviors, repent before God, and ask his family's forgiveness for not spending more time with them over the years. One thing he repeatedly talked about was his time at Little Prairie Bible Camp and recalling being baptized at 14 years old at the Rolla Church after a week of camp in 2000. He remembered the large Welcome Circle of church members welcoming him on that memorable occasion.

Consequently, Jordan's family has asked for memorial donations to be sent for LPBC. Jordan longed for those days of walking with God as his time grew short on this earth. He felt Gods peace and forgiveness before breathing his last. It is a great reminder of what an important work we do for Little Prairie Bible Camp. We have no idea how those short weeks of camp can impact a young life for the lord for the rest of their life.
